ELECTRONIC MEDICAL RECORDS

The Electronic Medical Records serves to facilitate easy access of patients' medical records by specialists at the main hospital. This ensures that a senior consultant's advice, if the need be, is made available at the time of entry of the patients. Implementation of the EMR is of extreme significance in today's health sector. While we have been able to implement its use at the main hospital, we are yet to use them in our teleophthalmology camps due to the high costs involved in using this method. Each laptop with a configuration to support the transfer of ophthalmic data with images from the camp site to the main hospital costs approximately Rs. 45, 000. We need at least six laptops (Rs.2, 70,000) for each mobile unit; we have five such units in different States (Total of Rs.13, 50,000).
